

About Your Insurance

There are two types of health insurances that will help pay for your eye care services and products. You may have both and our practice accepts both.

1. **Vision Care Plans** (such as VSP and EyeMed)
 2. **Medical Insurances** (such as BlueCross/ Blue Shield and United Health Care).
- **Vision Care Plans** only cover routine vision exams alone with eyeglasses and contact lenses. Vision plans only cover a basic screening for eye diseases. They do not cover diagnosis, management or treatment of eye diseases.
 - **Medical Insurances** must be used if you have any eye health problem or systematic health problem that has ocular complications. Your doctor will determine if these conditions apply to you, but some are determined by your case history.
 - If you have both types of insurance plans, it may be necessary for us to bill some service to one plan and other services to the other.
 - We will bill your insurance plan for services if we are a participating provider for that plan. We will try to obtain advanced authorization of your insurance benefits so we can tell you what is covered.
